ONLINE SAFETY

This week in school we marked **Safer Internet Day/Week**. We took this opportunity to talk with our children about developing healthy, respectful relationships in the online world. Please remember to monitor what your child is doing at home while online and how they are engaging with others. **Most social media platforms are not suitable for primary aged children as almost all require a minimum age of 13 years old.** As a school it is our stance that children should not be using social media platforms e.g. Tik Tok or any other flatform for which they are underage. As a parent, if you permit (or are complacent in their use), you must be fully aware of and accept the dangers. Children can be exposed to images of abuse, self-harm and can easily get involved in spats with peers creating stress and anxiety – all of which is avoidable.

If your child must have a mobile phone, please take this opportunity to check the devices settings and restrictions. This will help your child avoid seeing inappropriate content online, keeping them safe and happy.

There are various apps available to parents which enable you to track, monitor and restrict your child's use of online tools, for example the **FAMILY LINK APP** allows you to limit your child's time spent online e.g. to 1 hour per day. You can also set the device so it can not be used after an agreed time e.g. 6.00 pm or that certain platforms e.g. Tik Tok can not be accessed. As a school we very much encourage our parents to take ownership of this issue and put online safeguarding measures in place. Thank you all for your help with this.

P5-7	12.20 pm










