Enrolment for Primary 1, September 2019

Thank you to everyone who took the time to attend our Open Night yesterday evening. Our Pre-enrolment forms are available to download on our website.

The Education Authority has changed the enrolment process for primary 1 places and has moved to **an online application process.** We will send you the link for Primary 1 application once it is open.

As a reminder, please see below for a list key dates in the application process:

- <u>Wednesday 2nd January 2019</u> Online Primary 1 Application Procedure opens on EA website with online portal available
- Thursday 31st January 2019 Online portal closes at 12 midnight (any application received after this date will be treated as late)
- No later that Friday 15th February 2019 Ashgrove PS will select pupils at first preference stage
- Monday 25th March 2019 Final date by which EA will accept change of preferences, new applications or additional supporting information
- Thursday 9th May 2019 Ashgrove Primary will write to successful & unsuccessful applicants
- Thursday 23 May 2019, 4.00 pm Final date for the receipt of appeals
