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## School Routines...

At the beginning of a new school year it is very important we all establish good routines- this gives a sense of stability and security to our pupils. As a reminder, all pupils must be in school for 8.55a.m-the bell rings at this time and marks the beginning of the school day. Pupils arriving after this time are late.

Pupils are welcome to enter the school grounds from 8.40am when adults will be on duty in the Playgrounds. Please take note that pupils **MUST NOT** be left unsupervised in the school grounds before this time. As you are aware we have significant building work in the school site and for the safety of everyone pupils should not be left unattended.

Pupils may enter the building via the Primary 1 entrance, this door will be closed at 8.55am as soon as school starts. **We kindly ask Primary 2 parents to use the Primary 1 entrance rather than the main lobby.** If you are late please use the main entrance at Reception and Mrs Lamont will take your child to class.

We expect all pupils to walk to their own classroom by themselves from P2-7.

#### NO Chewing Gum Please!

I'm sure everyone has noticed the beautiful new paving which is being laid at the front of school outside the Primary 1 entrance- it looks super!

Unfortunately over the past few days adults who have been waiting outside the Primary 1 entrance have spat chewing gum on the paving.
