## Miss School=Miss Out!

The Department of Education is sharing with all parents a leaflet on why attendance at school is so important. Here are some of the ways parents can help in ensuring good levels of attendance...

- → Establish a good routine in the morning and evenings so your child is prepared for the day ahead.
- Make sure your child goes to school regularly and follows the school rules.
- → Ensure your child arrives to school on time— not late.
- → Arrange dental and medical appointments outside if school hours when possible.
- → Always inform the school is your child is absent due to illness—this should be followed up with a written note.

- → Do not take family holidays during term time.
- → Talk to your child about school and take an interest in their school work (including homework).
- → Attend parent teacher consultations and school events.
- Praise and reward your child's achievements at school.
- → Always support school staff in their efforts to control; difficult or challenging behaviour.
