#### ARE Results- Good Luck!

We will be thinking of our Primary 7 pupils on Saturday morning as they receive their AQE or GL results. Transfer Interviews for P7 pupils will take place next week. I wrote to P7 parents last week with an allocated date and time for us to complete the Transfer Application Form together- please read the guidelines sent home.

The result posted to you is a standardised score, a whole number between 55 and 145, with an average of 100. Last year the highest score issued by AQE was 129.

If your post does not arrive at your registered home address, the AQE Office (028 9022 4002) will be open from 2.00pm on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> January to allow for verbal results to be given over the phone (security questions must be passed). AQE will unfortunately not be able to answer any further questions other than that of your child's result. All other issues can be taken up from Monday 30th January.
