Safer Internet Day...

The Safeguarding Board for Northern Ireland has commissioned a first tour of "*In the Net*" across Northern Ireland for primary schools. The play puts forward and reinforces key messages about staying safe in the digital world and cyber-bullying. The campaign is supported by the Department of Education and the Education Authority for Northern Ireland.

The Theatre Company Alter Ego Creative Solutions will show a performance of the above play in School on MONDAY 20th FEBRUARY to pupils in P4-7.

The production explores the following issues in an educational and informative way;

- Safe Internet use
- Keeping personal information safe
- The effects of cyber-bullying on others
- What to do if you are being cyber-bullied
- What to do when you get that 'Uh-Oh' feeling
- What to do if you have questions or concerns

In conjunction with Safer Internet Day, the NSPCC is holding a parent/carers Workshop in St. Mary's on the Hill Primary School. Parents of all local primary schools are invited to attend. The workshop will explore what children do online, the risks that they may face and some tools which families can use to stay safe online.
