For even more festive fun we are also running a walking bus on this morning — a walking bus is when a group of parents and children walk together from a designated meeting point to the school, "picking up" other parents and children along the way.

We will be meeting at the building in Glengormley Park, ready to leave at 8.30am. Our route will then take us along Carnmoney Road, Glebe Road West, Liscoole Park and Ashgrove Road to school, arriving in time for school.

This event is for pupils *and* parents/adults; all children must be accompanied unless school holds permission for them to walk to school independently. Please note any children on bikes or scooters should make their own way to school.

If you own a business or know a business owner who would be willing to donate please ask them to contact us, we've never been known to turn anyone down.


