Rights Respecting Schools

Article 20 (children unable to live with their family)

"If a child cannot be looked after by their immediate family, the Government must give them special protection and assistance. This includes making sure the child has alternative care that is continuous."

(There is no need to keep your child off school if you find head lice, simply administer the treatment and come to school as usual).

Social Media, Children's Commissioner, Life in Likes Report

The Children's Commissioner has published a research based document "Life in Likes". The report highlights that while social media can be a positive tool for young people there can be negative impacts on mental health & well-being.

Most social media platforms have a minimum age of 13, but research shows that an increasing number of children under 13 are using social media with 75% of children aged 10-12 having their own accounts.
