### Primary 7 Transfer Arrangements

Placement letters for Primary 7 pupils will be posted to your home address on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May (today) – you should receive these on **SATURDAY 1<sup>st</sup> June.** The Education Authority will once again provide a helpdesk on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019 between the hours of 3.30pm and 5.00pm which parents can contact in the event that they do not receive a placement letter from the post primary school which has selected their child for admission. The Education Authority will write to parents of pupils who have not yet been allocated a school place

The Helpdesk will NOT have information about the placement of post primary placement of pupils who hold a statement of Special Educational Needs as these pupils are placed via a separate process managed by Special Education.
