Morning Routines...

Now that we have all settled back to school and our boys and girls are familiar once again with our routines, all children from P2-7 should walk into the school building by themselves. I am sure parents understand this is for Safeguarding reasons, thank you for your assistance with this.

School Carpark

Parents and visitors to school are welcome to use the Carpark facilities in our grounds. However, it is up to all adults to ensure the safety and care of our pupils and is paramount. For this reason, we ask everyone to adhere to the following:

- Speed limit of **5 MPH** (should be strictly adhered to)
- Vehicles should not be parked on pavements or access points at any time
- All drivers must observe the one-way system
- Please do not park across the zebra crossings
- Drivers must exercise extreme caution at all times when in school grounds
- Pedestrians should use the designated crossing areas & pathways
- Parents should get out of their car to collect their child and escort them to their vehicle or in to school (pupil safety comes first!)
- The disabled bays at the front of scho<mark>ol should only be</mark> used by blue badge holders
- Please show consideration for other drivers and remember the safety of our pupils is paramount

Morning Supervision

Over the past couple of weeks there have been a number of children who persistently arrive to school before **8.40am** and are left unsupervised in school grounds; this is compromising the safety of these pupils. Please be aware it is the responsibility of parents to ensure the supervision of their child/children until 8.40am. I will write to parents next week if their children are left unsupervised in school grounds.

Children arriving to school early must go to our **Breakfast Club** which starts at 8.00am. Breakfast is available for only £2.00 per day. Children arriving to school before 8.40am should make their way to the Breakfast Club via the P3/5 gate.

School Attendance HIGH IMPROTANCE

It is very important that our pupils attend school every day. Each day absent from school represents a day of lost learning. We understand that occasionally a child may be ill and not able to attend school – this should be rare.

Each month we closely monitor the attendance of all children. **If attendance falls below 85%** we will draw your attention to this matter. If your child is off school, please ring and leave a message to explain the absence and follow this up with a written explanation on the child's return to school.
