ENROLMENT FOR PRIMARY 1, SEPTEMBER 2020

The Education Authority has changed the enrolment process for primary 1 places and has moved to **an online application process.** We will send you the link for Primary 1 application once it is open.

As a reminder, please see below for a list key dates in the application process:

- **TUESDAY 2nd January 2020** Online Primary 1 Application Procedure opens on EA website with online portal available
- **THURSDAY 30 January 2020** Online portal closes at 12 midnight (all applications received after this date will be treated as late)
- No later than FRIDAY 14 February 2020 Ashgrove PS will select pupils at first preference stage
- TUESDAY 28 April 2020 Ashgrove Primary will write to successful & unsuccessful applicants
- WEDNESDAY 13 May 2020, 4.00 pm Final date for the receipt of appeals
