HALF TERM HOLIDAY

On Wednesday the Northern Ireland Executive announced that schools will close for Half Term from Monday 19th October - Friday 30th October (inclusive). School will restart on Monday 2^{nd} November at the usual times.

All schools will be closed for this period and there will be no provision for children of Key Workers awhich was available during the first lockdown. The Department of Education has also instructed schools that there will be no requirement to provide online provision for home learning.

During the week beginning 19th October, direct payments will be made to pupils in receipt of Free School Meals.

We hope all our children and families stay safe and well - we look forwad to welcoming you all back on Monday 2nd November.
