The Department of Education has shared information on why attendance at school is so important. Here are some of the ways parents can help in ensuring good levels of attendance...

- ➔ Establish a good routine in the morning and evenings so your child is prepared for the day ahead.
- ➔ Make sure your child goes to school regularly and follows the school rules.
- Ensure your child arrives to school on time- not late.
- ➔ Arrange dental and medical appointments outside of school hours when possible.
- Always inform the school if your child is absent due to illness- this should be followed up with a written note.

- Do not take family holidays during term time.
- → Talk to your child about school and take an interest in their school work (including homework).
- ➔ Attend parent teacher consultations and school events.
- ➔ Praise and reward your child's achievements at school.
- → Always support school staff in their efforts to control; difficult or challenging behaviour.
