Article 10 "Governments must respond quickly & sympathetically if a child or their parents apply to live in the same country. If a child's parents live apart in different countries, the child has the right to visit and keep in contact with both of them"

FINAL WEEK OF TERM ARRANGEMENTS

I am sure many of you are aware that the Minister of Education has stated all schools must remain open until the end of term, unless there are exceptional circumstances. A number of parents have contacted school to inform me that they intend to keep their children at home from Monday 14th December for personal reasons and to safeguard vulnerable members of their family over Christmas.

I understand that each family will have their own set of circumstances in the context of COVID and parents may make the difficult decision not to send their child to school next week. In these circumstances, we will use Code 8 on our registration which will not affect your child's overall attendance.

I emphasise that school will remain open and teachers will still be teaching in their classrooms. Therefore, if you choose not to send your child to school next week, only a limited amount of work will be shared on Google Classroom or See-Saw.

I'm sure you join me in thanking all staff for the tremendous efforts and lengths they have went to to help keep our children, school and community safe over the past few months.
