Safer Internet Day is on **Tuesday 8th February**. Never before has this issue been more important or relevant for our young people. The theme for Safer Internet Day this year is 'All fun and games? Exploring respect and relationships online'.

Safer Internet UK have a range of tips and strategies for parents/carers to support their children online at home. These include the following:

REASSURING YOUR CHILD THAT WHATEVER HAPPENS ONLINE, YOU ARE THERE TO SUPPORT THEM.

Let your child know that the best way to address any problem they have online, is to tell a trusted adult immediately. For example, this might include someone sending them a friend request; an online message; telling them to visit a specific website, or app; or asking them for their personal information. Reassure them that if anything happens online that they are unsure about, or makes them feel worried or upset, they can come to you for help.

KNOWING WHERE YOU CAN LEARN MORE ABOUT THEIR FAVOURITE APPS AND GAMES.

Websites like Common Sense Media or The Family Gaming Database can be invaluable sources of information. When your child starts talking about a new game or app, why not do some research into the reporting and blocking options available? Then you can help your child if they come to you with an issue

MOBILE PHONES IN SCHOOL

We discourage children from bringing mobile phones to school but we recognise that some parents wish them to do so for child care arrangements.

If a pupil must bring a mobile phone to school, it must remain switched off throughout the day and out of sight e.g. kept in a school bag or handed over to the teacher for safe keeping. Mobile phones which are used during the school day will be taken by an adult and returned at the end of the school day.

Should you as parents/carers need to contact your child throughout the day, this should only be done via the school office. Thank you for your help and consideration with this.
