Recently, we have had some children who are coming to school unwell with upset tummies or flu like symptoms. For the welfare of your child, please do not send them to school if they are ill. This also helps to prevent bugs and infections being spread round other children and staff in their class bubbles. Thank you for your help with this.

ILLNESS GUIDELINES Taken from Attendance Policy 2020

(The Information has been provided by the Health Protection Agency)

Chicken Pox	5 days absence from onset of rash
Whooping Cough	5 days absence from onset of rash
Scarlet Fever	5 days absence from onset of rash
Diarrohea/ Vomiting	Until symptoms have settled for 24 hours
Headlice	None

It is great that almost all of our restrictions in school have been lifted. We do however still ask parents to be mindful of symptoms of COVID and please do not send your child to school if they are ill.

AQE INFORMATION 2022

Registration for AQE assessments is now open. Registration closes on **Friday 23rd September**, 5.00pm. It is the responsibility of P6 parents/carers to register their child for these assessments. Applications can be completed online via the AQE website, or alternatively, a hard copy application form will be available to download and print.

Parents/Guardian will need the following three elements to complete their application, **as well as** having a completed application form:

- A recent photograph of your child (can be taken straight from a mobile device and uploaded)
- A scanned copy of your child's birth certificate (long or short version) **or** a scanned copy of the id page of their passport.
- Payment of the registration fee (£60.00). Parents/guardians of a child who is entitled to Free School Meals, and who provide evidence of such entitlement, **will not have to pay the fee.**

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, you will need to send a letter of confirmation from the Education Authority or a letter of confirmation from school. To request this, please email info@ashgroveps.newtownabbey.ni.sch.uk

- contact the teacher if there are any issues with understanding or completing homework
