DOODLE MATHS...

In Ashgrove we are once again purchasing for each child an individual online maths programme via Doodle Maths. Many of our children should already be familiar with this and using it regularly as part of homework or extra maths support. This is a significant investment on the part of the school therefore we would like to see it being used by everyone.

I encourage you to download the Doodle Maths (and Doodle Tables) app to your digital devices. Teachers may set Doodle Maths as a homework task... We encourage all our children to login every day and spend 10-15 minutes on their assigned tasks.

The tasks set are individualised for each child meaning that worked is pitched to each child's particular level. The programme will identify what your child already knows and will then set new learning tasks to help move them on with their learning.
